CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

July 28-30, 2017 Gallatin County Fairgrounds

FOUNDATION HORSEMANSHIP CLASS: (Three-day Clinic) July 28-30, 2017

This class is for the green rider or the green horse who may feel the need for additional groundwork prior to riding. During each of the three-day sessions the first part of the class is dedicated to working the horse from the ground in preparation for riding, with the remainder of the class for riding.

Limited to 25 horses and riders.

Registration:	Friday July 28 -- 8:00 - 8.30 am
Clinic:	Friday, Saturday and Sunday -- 9:00 - 12:00 PM each day
Class Size:	Limited to 25 horses and riders
Cost:	\$700.00
Deposit required:	\$350.00 (non-refundable unless true emergency)
NOTE:	Bring Snaffle Bit.

HORSEMANSHIP 2 CLASS: (Three-day Clinic) July 28-30, 2017

The next phase in the development of the versatile bridle horse. Horsemanship 2 introduces the rider to working the horse in the hackamore and beyond. Horsemanship 1 is a prerequisite for enrolling in the Horsemanship 2 unless otherwise approved by Buck. The class involves roping so that all aspects in preparing the bridle horse-in-the-making are addressed.

Registration:	Friday July 28 -- 12:30 PM – 1:00 PM
Clinic:	Friday, Saturday and Sunday -- 1:30 - 4:30 PM each day
Class Size:	Limited to 15 riders and horses
Cost:	\$700.00
Deposit required:	\$350.00 (non-refundable unless true emergency)
Requirements:	See class description sheet
NOTE:	For horses in hackamore, two-rein, or straight up in bridle or in snaffle bit to be started in hackamore on day 1 of clinic. Bring hackamore, 2 rein outfit or bridles and lariat at least 50' long.

This class will be a Horsemanship 2 class **without cattle**. All roping will be done on roping dummies. For the refinement of both horse and ride. Limited to 15 riders and horses.

1. For experienced riders **and** experienced horses. Horses should be well mannered and not spooky.
2. Do **not** register for this class if horse and/or rider is green.
3. Horse and rider should be able to perform the following maneuvers
 - a. Ride a smooth circle, at trot and lope on a loose rein with roundness, nose looking into the circle with the front quarters and hindquarters reaching evenly.
 - b. Simple lead changes (preferably flying lead changes)
 - c. Counter canter
 - d. Simple spins
 - e. Horse should be comfortable to rope from. We will use roping dummies.
 - f. Good control of horse's hindquarters at all times
4. Horse should be in a hackamore, two rein or straight up in the bridle. Can be in snaffle bit, ready to go into the hackamore. If this is the case, please bring a good rawhide core bosal with a mecate for Buck to fit to your horse.
5. Please be honest about your ability and the ability of your horse, Buck will not work on basic horsemanship, taking time away from those qualified to be in this class. Also, with limited enrollment, we do not want to turn away qualified participants by enrolling unqualified participants. **If you have any doubt in your ability or the ability of your horse, please call Pete Melniker (406) 570-4270 or email buck@doublediamondhalters.com**

All participants required to complete waiver upon registration. Registration forms will not be processed without deposit and completed waiver. Forms will be processed on first come, first served based on postmarks. PLEASE DOWNLOAD WAIVER FORM FROM OUR WEB SITE. Guardians must sign for minors. Minor will not be allowed to participate if waiver is not signed by guardian before the class starts. No dogs allowed on premises at any time. No tent camping.
